New style training table casters are replacing the skate wheel caster which will be phased out.

Affects: Elements & Morpheus



New “Ultra-Flip” Mechanism universally replaces the following:

All Beam Flip – Affects Bridges, Elements, & Morpheus

All Cable Flip – Affects Bridges

All Ready Flip – Affects Elements, & Morpheus

All Lever Flip - Affects Elements, Morpheus, & Zume

Twister II Ultra-Flip (coming soon) is designed similarly, but improves upon our discontinued Twister table.

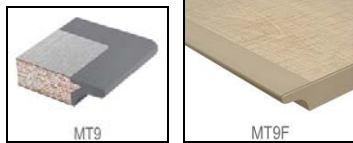

MT9 & MT9F Urethane edge – similar to our MT7, the beefier MT9/MT9F profile allows for PVC edging to “cap” off the edges to allow for smoother and more rigid table joining.
