

CARB STATEMENT OF CONFORMANCE

Dear Valued Customers,

SurfaceWorks® is committed to full compliance with the California Air Resources Board (CARB) ATCM 93120 code regulation. This Airborne Toxic Control Measure is to reduce formaldehyde emissions from all composite wood products such as particleboard, medium-density fiberboard etc. All SurfaceWorks laminated panel products conform to these emission standards.

Phase 2 regulations, in effect since January 1, 2011, require that particle board does not exceed 0.09 ppm and MDF does not exceed 0.11 ppm concentration of formaldehyde.

SurfaceWorks is in full compliance with phase 2 regulations on all products regardless of state to which they will be shipped.

For customers who wish to specify wood products with even lower formaldehyde concentrations, SurfaceWorks offers NAF particle board which has a maximum formaldehyde concentration of 0.01 ppm. This option can be specified for all products ordered for an additional charge.

The statement made in this letter does not extend to any item added post production to SurfaceWorks products by any other manufacturer, person, or user or any products subjected to unintended contamination, misuse, neglect or accident.
