

LAMINATE SURFACES

- To maintain the beauty of decorative laminates, clean with a solution of liquid dishwashing detergent and warm water. Dry with a clean, non-abrasive cloth. This should remove most stains from the surface.
- For stubborn stains, use a house-hold cleaner such as Formula 409®, Fantastik®, Windex®, or diluted Simple Green®. It may be necessary to use a soft bristle brush with light scrubbing to assist in removing the stain.
- If stain persists, try a mixture of baking soda and water. Apply with a soft bristle brush and lightly scrub for 10-20 strokes. Baking soda is a mild abrasive cleaner, use as instructed. Another option is undiluted bleach, immediately rinsing with warm water. Do not allow bleach to sit on stain for more than 1-½ minutes. **WARNING:** Prolonged exposure of bleach to laminate will cause discoloration.
- **DO NOT USE** any type of abrasive cleaners, as this will cause scratching and discoloration of laminate. Use baking soda as instructed above.
- For high gloss laminates, clean with a solution of liquid dishwashing detergent and warm water. Dry with a clean non-abrasive cloth; this cleaning will probably leave streak marks. To remove streaks, add a final cleaning using glass cleaner with ammonia. Dry with a clean, non-abrasive cloth.
