







WOOD EDGES

For routine cleaning, dust with a damp, soft cloth, using another soft cloth to dry. Always wipe the surface in the direction of the wood grain. All spills should be wiped up immediately with a soft, absorbent cloth and not allowed to dry.

When more intensive cleaning and disinfecting is necessary, clean the surface with a gentle cleaner such as the cleaners listed below or a mild detergent. Dilute in accordance with manufacturer's directions. Dampen, but do not saturate, a soft cloth with the diluted cleaning solution and wipe the surface in the direction of the wood grain. Dry surface with a clean soft cloth.

To determine if a cleaning product is safe to use on wood furniture read the label and use as directed. Do not use hard bristle brushes. Do not use products designed for non-porous surfaces or products labeled "abrasive" or corrosive." Solvents, ammonia and wax should never be used on your wood edge furniture. Products of this nature can scratch, discolor or remove wood finish.
